



“Old School” Catfish Fisherman Reveals Two Quick ‘N Dirty Secrets For Getting The Big Ones To Bite Almost Instantly!

Dear Fisherman,

I'll tell ya, interviewing “Albert The Catfish Fisherman” was probably one of the best hours I've ever spent on the phone.

Not only did he give me a boatload of easy – immediately useable tips for catching more catfish than 95% of the other guys – but he gave me a few lessons about life too.

For now, I wanted to give you a quick “bulleted” summary of the techniques he reveals in the two interview clips. (This is for you guys that just want get right to the heart of everything, quick)

Interview #1: There is something about the “wind” for catching Catfish

1. Days when there is a little wind are always best.
2. If the water is completely still, no wind, Albert won't even both going fishing. Just enjoy, swim, etc...but don't fish.
3. You want to fish the bank that puts the wind into your face.
4. Reason: This wind will move the top of the water towards you, and will push the plankton to the bank.
5. Bait fish, and other living things will follow the plankton to your bank, and guess what that means?
6. Catfish will follow right underneath these smaller fish, all the way to your shore...so bait, drop it in, and pull up catfish till the cows come home...works GREAT!

Interview #2: Why a skipjack is the best cut bait

1. It's actually, in most parts of the country, called a freshwater herring. In Arkansas and nearby states, they call it a skipjack.

2. Found in some rivers (the Aransas river is one of them), and they can sometimes get 24 inches long or more.
3. Cut them up into bloody strips to use as bait for catfish – it is the “go to” bait for old school fishermen in that area, and if you find some, it will be your “go to” bait to. It works that good.
4. The key is to make sure it is “bloody” fresh. If some time passes and the blood is gone, you gotta switch out with a fresh strip. Catfish don't like “dead” things...and if it doesn't have blood on it, and it's not moving...it's “dead”, and they will ignore it.

I hope you enjoyed the interview clips as much as I did making them. Albert is quite a guy. I couldn't thank him enough for spending time talking to me. When guys older than me talk, I listen – especially when they talk about fishing.
